Once again renewal is upon us. I have managed to contain the cost of all categories, so they are as shown overleaf.

Those members who normally pay by Euros and can only send paper notes in multiples of 5 Euros, are advised instead to buy **£30 (GBPs)** and send those. With fluctuating exchange rates it is much easier, and probably cheaper, for you to buy **£30** than me try to exchange Euros to get near to £30.

I can accept payment through PayPal (brookjeremy@hotmail.com) and this is the preferred payment method and certainly cheaper than Euros & Postage. A surcharge of **£2** is needed to cover PayPal's costs, if you want protection. However, if you make your PayPal transfer a **private** one, the whole amount gets transferred! So **do not** mention the Club or why you are paying, or your address, etc!! You are making a **private** transfer to me as an individual and save yourself £2! I will know what any payment is for and you will have let me know by the normal email.

The closure of my local bank branch means that cheque and cash payments are more difficult for me to pay in, although I can pay in through my local Post Office! It is easier and safer to pay by **BACs** (put your name on the Bank form so I know who it is coming from) and one can email the Renewal Form to me at brookjeremy@hotmail.com to confirm payment which also saves postage.

There have been a lot of improvements to the magazine last year and I hope you will continue with your membership of the Club.

Previously, starting with CS66, there were an extra 4 colour pages in each issue making 28 pages per issue including 8 colour pages. The weight of the new magazine is just under 90 gms but by using plastic envelopes I can keep the weight down to under 100 gms! I added a further 4 pages of colour for 2020! The magazine is now 32 pages.

Your early renewal is much appreciated, as Club funds are often short at the beginning of the year!

Also if you don't intend to renew, please advise me quickly to save unnecessary postage costs.

I hope you will all have a happy, prosperous and Covid-free 2023.
